✚ **MEMBERSHIP DRAW:** **Every Friday.** Jackpots by \$50.00/week – be present between 6-7.30pm.

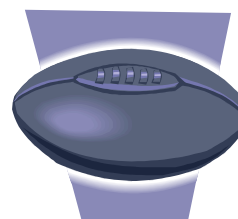

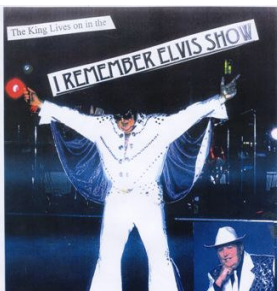


We will also be running an 8-Ball Competition on Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> March to raise funds for this, and plenty of raffles.
